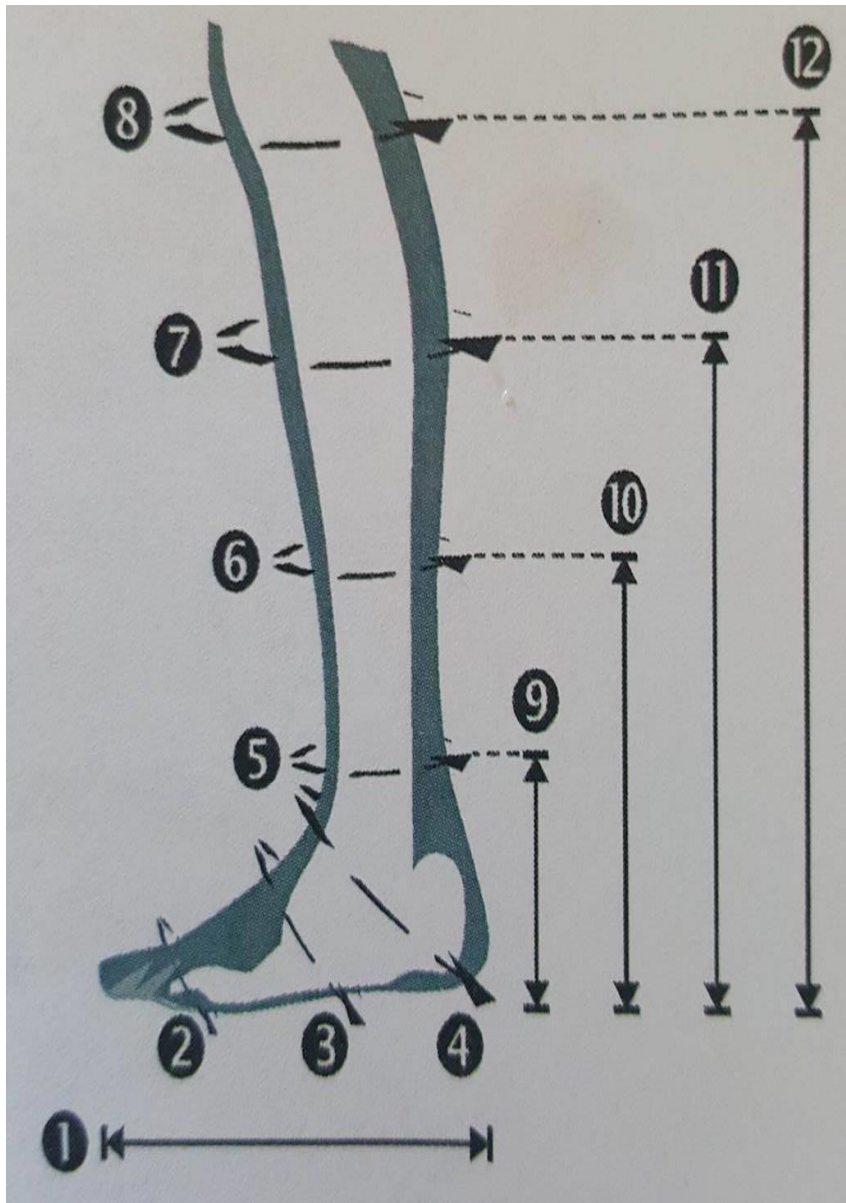


Measuring



- Take measurements in cm wearing jodhpurs and socks normally worn
- Ensure tape measure is neither tight nor loose for measurements except for foot length
- All measurements to be taken sitting except for foot length and leg height

1. Foot length.
Run the tape measure diagonally from heel to big toe standing. Also provide a tracing on paper on a hard floor and EU sizing

2 – 5 as per diagram

1. Ball of foot
2. Instep
3. Heel
4. Ankle

5. Lower calf – measures where calf muscle finishes
6. Calf – find the widest point of the calf

7. Top of boot – measure around top of leg where boot would finish – use leg height place remembering the boots will drop 2 cm
8. Height A – measure from ground to height from ground where ankle measurement was taken (between 10 and 13 cm)
9. Height B – measure from ground to lower leg measurement place (between 22 and 26 cm)
10. Height C – taken from ground to calf measurement place (between 32 and 37 cm)
11. Height D – taken from ground to crease in the back of knee

Terms and Conditions

Payment:

A 50% deposit is required at time of ordering. The balance is payable when the boots come into N.Z. In the event of a client wishing to cancel their order, once the boots have started in production, the deposit are non-refundable as the boots are made to the client's specific measurement. A \$20 P&P is applicable to postage within N.Z.

Order time:

The boots take 10 – 12 weeks from time of ordering as Celeris Boots are totally hand made by craftsmen, this is a process that can't be hurried. Unfortunately we are experiencing some delays with the dressage model. Celeris is doing everything possible to eliminate these delays, but this will take a few months to achieve.

Warranty:

Our aim is that every LH Equestrian customer is 100% with their Celeris boots with regard to fit and quality. The measurement guide needs to be followed carefully to ensure correct measurements are supplied. As the boots are completely made to measure, a refund cannot be offered due to incorrect measurements being supplied (we are available to assist with any queries the customer may have during the measurement process). L.H. Equestrian takes the measurement a great fit is guaranteed. In the unlikely event of a fault in either quality or fit from the workshop, a replacement pair will be provided.
